The Truth at the Heart of the Lie How the Catholic Church Lost its Soul

JAMES CARROLL

Labelled as ‘one of the most adept and versatile writers on the American scene today’ (*Denver Post*), James Carroll is a prolific and much-awarded author of 20 books, including his memoir *An American Requiem*, which won the National Book Award. In a 2019 cover article for *The Atlantic*, Carroll responded to the ongoing scandal of sex abuse by Catholic priests by advocating for the abolition of the priesthood in order to ‘return the Church to the people’. Carroll carries this anti-clerical argument further in *The Truth at the Heart of the Lie*. From the beginnings of his faith as a boy to his gradual disillusionment as a Catholic, Carroll weaves together the story of his quest to understand his personal beliefs and his relationship to the Catholic Church, with the history of the Church itself. In a deeply personal re-examination of self, Carroll grapples with his own feelings of being chosen, his experiences as a priest, and the moments of doubt that made him leave the priesthood and embark on a long personal journey toward renewal.

Courageous and inspiring, Carroll offers a razor-sharp examination both of himself and how the Church became an institution that – through an all-male clergy – placed power and dominance over people.
